Construction material was transported by local porters organized by TAAN, sponsored by WFP in late Aug 2015. The progress of main truss structure was delayed by the fuel crisis occurred from Sep 2015 until now. Although the slow progress due to fuel shortage, the truss was aimed to be done by JAN., 2016. The local community and SMC will be contributing the manpower to complete the half wall and ground with local materials by mid-Feb. 2016.

Annex I I: Activities of Post-Quake Relief and Rehabilitation

Target Group	Poor and Victims of the earthquake hit areas
May 3, 2015 	The Promise, Medi Peace, Child Fund with the coordination of EPF Nepal distributed 1 Pack of rice, 1 kg of salt and 1kg of Daal per household of all people of Katunje VDC. There were altogether 350 households.
May 6, 2015	The international organizations: The Promise, Child Fund and Medi Peace provided the food materials in Baseri VDC. 200 bags of rice, 1000 Kg salt and 500 liters oil were distributed to the people of Baseri VDC of Dhading District.
May 7, 2015 	EPF Nepal with the financial support of the Promise, Child Fund and Medi Peace distributed 350 bags of rice; 1000 kg of salt, 350 liters of oil in Budhathum VDC of Dhading district. Most of the people had destroyed homes and food materials due to devastating earthquake.
May 8, 2015	People from Jyamrung ward no 5 got earthquake relief materials which were distributed by Ecological Protection Forum Nepal . The people of 50 households got the relief material rice. Each house got 1 bag of rice. Mr. Ramesh Dhamala, founder chairperson of EPF Nepal distributed the rice to the people of Jyamrung.
May 14, 2015	The Promise, Child Fund and Medi Peace supported to the people of Ree VDC who were shifted in Dhading besi as refugee had provided 40 bags of rice, 40 KGs of salt, 40 liters of oil, 40 Kg of garlic and onion, 40 Kg of potato respectively. Moreover, the organizations supported kitchen utensils, blankets, clothes, mosquito nets. Each family got one

Summary of Post-Quake Health Camp in Katunje VDC (10-14th April 2015)



Medical Team of Taiwan

Introduction of the Service Team

The mobile service team comprised a group of 10 Taiwanese, was led by Dr. Hsu Shih Tien, total four doctors, five nurses and one assistant from Taiwan. The team combined two private hospitals' resources, namely Landseed Hospital and E-Da Hospital from Taiwan.

While the local team was led by EPF-NEPAL, Mr. Ramesh Dhamala with three kitchen staff and 10 student volunteers to provide translation for medical team, conducting patients' registration and assisting on dressing and instructing medicine usage.

The Health Officer of Katunje VDC, Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Yadav suggested us to cover the service area of ward 1-4 where is far away from the health post (ward 9). 2-day Home service was arranged by him and led by community health worker while our main camp (ward 2) also received patients for more complicated treatment which the home service team can't perform. The mobile team worked five hours around the ward 1 & 3. During the service period, 3pm, 12 May, the 2nd big earthquake happened and our team was in the village. The home visiting team led by Dr. Hsu Shih-Tien (Landseed Hospital) who didn't stop the service, treating patients in front of the rubbles and checking the elders at their homes.

Next morning, the mobile team was sent out to set up in a higher school of Selle (Ward 4), led by Dr. Sun Chuo-Chun (E-DA Hospital), total 2 doctors and 2 nurses with local volunteers from EPF to provide health service from 10am to 4pm. In the main camp, we also received many patients referred from ward 4 to have further treatment which mobile team cannot perform.

By the end of the health camp, all of remaining medical supply was donated to the VDC health post, received by Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Yadav.
